To comply with new Alberta Education reporting requirements and in an effort to centralize and improve access, parents will be able to pay their children's school fees through a NEW simplified and secure online website that is accessed through the PowerSchool Parent Portal.

The Wolf Creek online payment system allows you to pay for:

- ⇒ Yearbook
- ⇒ Library Fines
- ⇒ Field Trip Fees

You can use the Acorn online payment system to:

- ⇒ Make fee payments for all students in your family at one time
- ⇒ View your entire payment history
- ⇒ View all your upcoming fee payments in one place
- ⇒ Print payment receipts
- ⇒ Print student account statements
