BOB & JEAN SPENCER SCHOLARSHIP

Annually, the Central Alberta Vintage Auto Club accepts applications for its \$1000 scholarship. This scholarship is open to Grade 12 students attending central Alberta high schools who have achieved at least 15 credits in mechanics/automotives related courses at the high school level, and who graduated in June of the most recent school year. In addition, applicants must be furthering their education in the automotive field by being enrolled in an automotive-related program in a post-secondary institution in Alberta, or must have a plan for apprenticeship. Confirmation of these requirements must be contained in the application.

Qualified students must submit applications to the appropriate individual/committee in their high school, and this committee will select the most-deserving candidate and then submit that application to the Central Alberta Vintage Auto Club at Box 752, Red Deer, Alberta, T4N 5H2.

Applications received by the school not later than June 15 of that year will be those that will be considered. The successful candidate will be presented with the scholarship at the annual club function in October, at which she/he is expected to be in attendance.
