GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to every community with a Moose Lodge: Camrose, Lloydminster, Medicine Hat, Ponoka, Wetaskiwin.
- 2. All Alberta grade 12 students registered at a recognized Alberta Community College or University as a full-time student will be eligible.
- 3. Any grade 12 student that meets the above criteria may submit his or her name to their Lodge by June 1st.
- 4. Each Lodge will choose two winners of the scholarship by lottery from all entries.
- 5. One alternate shall be selected if a winner does not attend an Alberta Community College or University in the fall.
- 6. Each Lodge shall submit the name of the winners and alternates to the Alberta Moose Association Charities Chairman.
- 7. The winner of each scholarship shall submit a Letter of Acceptance from the institution, by June 1st of the same year, to:
