RE: Follow-Up Information for Parents/Guardians

This is a communication to update families on the status of negotiations between the Alberta Teachers' Association (ATA) and the Teachers' Employer Bargaining Association (TEBA).

We have been informed the two parties will be re-engaging in formal negotiations starting on Tuesday, October 14, immediately following Thanksgiving, and will be assisted by a Mediator. Knowing this, and knowing once an agreement is reached at the table it must also be ratified, it is quite possible schools will remain closed the week of October 14-17, 2025. We remain unable to forecast exactly when classes will resume for students, however we wanted to share this information with families now so parents/guardians can plan accordingly for next week.

We are hopeful for a positive outcome next week, and the return of students and staff to our schools as soon as possible. More information will be shared as soon as it is available. Thank you for your ongoing patience and understanding during this difficult time.
